• ANY CHANGES MADE AFTER CLOSING DATE will be charged: \$15

• Haul-in Fee: \$15 per horse per day (only if not doing stall)

Bad Check Fee: \$50

• INCLUDE WITH ENTRY Copies of RMDS cards and USEF AA status if applicable.

• Make checks payable to RMDS and mail to Heather Petersen. If you are mailing overnight, please waive the required signature for delivery – If you do not waive the signature, you will be charged \$5.

Management Rules and Procedures

During the competition, the performance arenas will be open to hand walking only up to one half hour prior to the start of the first class. No horses will be allowed in the performance arenas during breaks. One bridle number is always required if horse not tied to trailer or out of stall. ALL dogs **must** be leashed and attached to a person or immovable object *at all times*! \$50 fine for all violations. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK OR RMDS STANDING RULES WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Sharps containers will be available in the stabling area and also in the show office for trailer in horses. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Post entries accepted on first come first served basis with space available. Wait list will be maintained through Sunday 8pm. *NO SMOKING IN BARNS*. **Freestyle entries:** Sound checks will be Tuesday before the start of the arenas or another time set up in advance with the show office once ride times have been released. Music will be accepted on a CD or flash drive only.

Management reserves the right to: Add or cancel judges; Combine, divide, limit or cancel classes; Refuse entries for cause; Waive penalty fees.

TIMES

Provisional ride times will be posted at www.rmds.org, and www.twowhitefeet.com. Official times will be posted at the show office by Tuesday morning.

REFUNDS

The office fee is non-refundable. Entries cancelled on or before the closing date will receive a refund of all fees except the office fee. No refunds if cancelled after the closing date unless ride is filled from waitlist. Waitlist maintained through Sunday, September 10, 2017. No refunds of any kind for any reason including Acts of God during show day.

IMPORTANT: All cancellations must be made in writing and mailed, faxed, or e-mailed to show secretary.

You are responsible to confirm that your cancellation has been received. Anyone not appearing for any of their dressage tests without prior notification to the show secretary will be "scratched" from their remaining classes. Those rides will be filled if possible.

STABLING - Bedding not included - NOTE TWO DIFFERENT PRICING OPTIONS AVAILABLE!

Permanent 10x12 stalls with hard packed floors and the possible addition of stall mats and full doors or Tent 10x10 temporary stalls with full doors and hard packed floors. Bedding required and must be purchased from the facility. Advance bedding orders with entries will be placed in stalls prior to arrival. The CHP feed office will have limited hours so it is best to order your bedding with your entry to make sure you have some when you arrive!

Haul-in fee: \$15 per day (only if not doing a stall or paddock)

- Individual days of stabling WILL be stabled in separate area from package stalls AND MOST LIKELY IN TENT STALLS.
- Bedding and feed can be purchased on the grounds; Very limited hours.
- Stalls will be available at 10:00 AM on the Tuesday prior to show weekend. If you desire other arrangements, you **MUST** speak with Heather prior to sending your entry.
- Priority will be given to stalls for horses before tack stalls if stabling fills.
- HORSES ENTERED IN USDF CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES MUST HAVE A STALL. HAUL INS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED PER USEF RULES.
- Outside bedding is NOT allowed on the show grounds.

OFFICE HOURS (Subject to change)

- Tuesday, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM;
- Wednesday through Sunday 7:00 AM until 1 hour after final ride or as posted in show office.

ARENAS

- Outdoor arenas have all weather sand/fiber mix footing.
- Warm-up arenas have comparable footing.
- NO LUNGEING in warmup arenas use lunging arenas only.
- Coaching may be done from the outside of the arenas ONLY.
- Competition arenas will be open for schooling on set-up day, Tuesday and/or Wednesday (before show weekend) until posted close time in show office. Limited schooling may be available in the evening by management decision. Hours and availability will be posted in the show office.

DIRECTIONS

Colorado Horse Park (CHP) is located on Bayou Gulch Rd, off of Hwy 83.

<u>From the North</u>: Hwy 83 South five miles from downtown Parker (go past entrance to Pinery and Timers) to Bayou Gulch Road (at Ponderosa High School), turn East, CHP is about 1 mi. on the left.

<u>From the South</u>: Hwy 83 North, three miles North of Franktown is Bayou Gulch (at Ponderosa High School), turn East, CHP is about 1 mi. on the left .
