Equipment Checker

Before starting your job

- 1. Make sure you have the following supplies:
 - A copy of the ride times schedule on a clipboard
 - A pen or pencil
 - Non-latex gloves
 - Chart and description of legal saddles, cavessons and bits
 - Trash container for used gloves
 - Tape measure with centimeters

Procedures for Equipment Checkers

- 1. Plan to check at least 1/3 of the horse/rider competitors.
- 2. Approach a rider after he/she has exited the competition arena and politely ask if it is all right to check the equipment.
- 3. Move rider and horse to a safe place. Use common sense to make sure of the safety of horse and rider and other competitors.
- 4. Always wear latex gloves when slipping your fingers into the horse's mouth to determine the type of bit. Use a new glove for each horse.
- 5. Visually check the saddle and cavesson. Measure the whip: maximum length is 102 cm or 47.2 inches (roughly 47 ½ inches).
- 6. Check the spur area. If you see blood, notify the TD.

- 7. If you encounter any equipment violations, immediately contact the Technical Delegate to handle the problem. Keep the horse and rider with you till the TD arrives.
- 8. Make a notation on your schedule to indicate which horses/riders were checked.

Behavior guidelines for Equipment Checkers

- Be courteous and tactful.
- Thank competitors for their cooperation.
- If anyone protests, let the TD handle it.
