## Waiting for tests to be finished

1. A runner should have a designated waiting place, with a chair available, set up the required 20 meters from the competition arena.

## **Collecting tests from the scribe**

- Walk quietly to the judge's stand as the rider in the arena finishes the final salute and leaves the arena. The runner should not talk to either the judge or scribe if they are still finishing marking the test for the preceding ride.
- 2. Take the test(s) to the scorers.
- 3. Return to the waiting place.

## **Behavior guidelines for Runners**

- If the scribe asks for coffee, snacks, pencils, etc., go to the show office to get them. Do this while waiting for rides to finish. Never interrupt judge or scribe while there is a test in progress.
- 2. Do not walk closer than 20 meters (67 feet) from the competition arena during a test.
- 3. Anything a runner hears about competitors or horses from the judge or scribe is confidential and not to be repeated.
- 4. Just carry the test. DO NOT READ IT.
